## OPEN GYM GUIDELINES

### **OPEN GYM PROGRAM:**

Open Gym is designed for recreational, drop-in basketball play. Open gym allows the opportunity for exercise in a fun, non-competitive environment by allowing athletes, young and old, to refine their skills and learn from one another. It also provides an environment for parents and teenagers to play basketball together. Covington Community Sports will supply a men's regulation size basketball and reversible "pennies" to be used for play. Please set your expectations with this in mind, so as you head to open gym you are prepared to have a good time.

Open Gym times are set aside each week depending upon gym availability and are subject to change without notice.

**To participate, individuals must pay the daily fee of \$2, present a photo ID card to staff on duty and sign the registration release at the gym.**

### **AGE OF PARTICIPATION:**

Open Gym is open to participants ages 14 and older (based on their age at the time of attendance). Participants in the 14-17 age range must be accompanied by an adult and the registration release must be signed by a parent prior to participating in open gym.

### **OPEN GYM POLICIES:**

- No dunking or hanging on the basketball rims.
- Outside organizations are not permitted to hold team practices or conduct drills during open gym times.
- Shirts must be worn at all times. Non-marking, athletic shoes only. Open Gym is a family-friendly atmosphere. Please no offensive clothing such as profanity or graphics of an adult-nature. Shoes with wheels are NOT allowed in the gym.
- No food, chewing gum or beverages other than water allowed in gymnasium.
- It is expected for all players to abide by the universal rules of good conduct, fair play and good sportsmanship. Covington Community Sports reserves the right to suspend and remove any participant who uses inappropriate language and/or unsportsmanlike behavior, including but not limited to, striking a participant or staff member, spitting, throwing, kicking or striking of objects in a threatening or dangerous manner or harassing behavior such as following another participant or staff member off the court, into the parking lot or off the premises, or any attempt to block the departure of other players or staff member from their departure is also prohibited. Decisions made by CCS staff can be protested in writing to the Sportsmanship Review Panel.
